FINAL JUDGMENT. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant and its members, including but not limited to member-leaders Matthew Hale, Thomas Kroenke, Christopher Lee Peterson, Olivier (a/k/a Oliver) Devalez, Alexandro Di Civita, Kirk W. Schmidt, Thomas George Padgett, Jon Fox, and Richard A. Marraccini, on Plaintiff's claims under the Lanham Act 15 U.S.C. § 1051 et. seq.; the Illinois Trademark Registration Protection Act, 765 ILCS 1036/65 (1998); the Illinois Uniform Deceptive Trade Practices Act, 815 ILCS 510/1 et. seq. (1992); and Illinois common law.

Judgment is entered that Defendant World Church and its members (including but not limited to member-leaders Matthew Hale, Thomas Kroenke, Christopher Lee Peterson, Olivier (a/k/a Oliver) Devalez, Alexandro Di Civita, Kirk W. Schmidt, Thomas George Padgett, Jon Fox, and Richard A. Marraccini, and other officers, directors, predecessors, successors, assigns, agents, employees, representatives, attorneys, and all other persons acting for, with, by, or under authority from it, or in concert or participating with it, and others having knowledge of this Order, are permanently enjoined and restrained as described in the Order and Injunction entered November 19, 2002 (Paragraph 4 of which included the specific injunction and restraint from directly or indirectly: (a) using the name and mark CHURCH OF THE CREATOR or any colorable facsimile thereof, including specifically WORLD CHURCH OF THE CREATOR. WCOTC, COTC, or the words "Church" and "Creator(s)" together in the same name or mark, in connection with its proselytizing, business, products, services or Web sites, and/or from providing a link to Plaintiff's Web site www.churchofthecreator.org; or (b) using the domain names "churchofthecreator.com" or "wcotc.com" or any other domain name which would violate subpart (a) above, including in metatags or other invisible text; or (c) doing any other act or thing calculated or likely to create or induce the belief that defendant's operations or publications and/or Internet web page(s) are in any way affiliated, connected, associated, sponsored, licensed or authorized by or with Plaintiff.)

Judgment is entered that Defendant and its members, including but not limited to member-leaders Matthew Hale, Thomas Kroenke, Christopher Lee Peterson, Olivier (a/k/a Oliver) Devalez, Alexandro Di Civita, Kirk W. Schmidt, Thomas George Padgett, Jon Fox, and Richard A. Marraccini, are and were in contempt of the November 19, 2002 Order and Injunction, and are and shall be jointly and severally liable to the Plaintiff for \$200,000.00 in sanctions for same.

Judgment is entered that Defendant and its members, including but not limited to member-leaders Matthew Hale, Thomas Kroenke, Christopher Lee Peterson, Olivier (a/k/a Oliver) Devalez, Alexandro Di Civita, Kirk W. Schmidt, Thomas George Padgett, Jon Fox, and Richard A. Marraccini, are to pay Plaintiff an additional \$1,132.20 for costs.
